It was s nice to see so many families at our 3rd grade Back to School Night. If you were unable to attend, I sent a packet of information home with your child. We had a great first full week in third grade! We talked about habits 1, 2, 4, and 5 (we're waiting for our planners to talk about Put First Things First), and the students did such a nice job with the activities we did to practice each habit. We are still working on some of our beginning of the year assessments. Once I am finished with everything, I will send the students' results home with them. I will use the results from the assessments to help plan my instruction so I can best meet the needs of each student.

We will start homework next week. The students will be responsible to read for 20 minutes each night (1 night over the weekend days) for a total of 100 minutes/week. The math assignment will be to practice their multiplication/division facts for at least 10 minutes or complete the math daily lesson review sheet if one is sent home.
