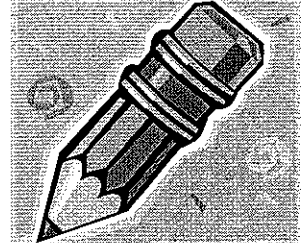

**Writing:** We will continue to work on our persuasive writing. We are working on giving specific details and examples to support our arguments.

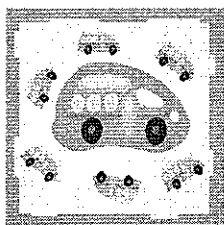

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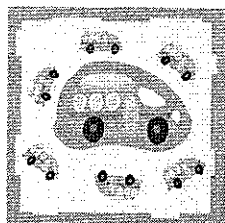
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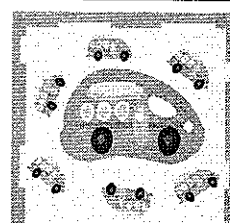


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# Summer Reading Skills PROGRAMS
