Dear Parents and Guardians,

Once a month we get together with Mrs. Campbell's kindergarten class to do a buddy activity with them. This year our activities have been helping us to get to know the 7 Habits a little bit better. We did a great activity with our Kindergarten Buddies this week to help us practice the 5th habit, "Seek First to Understand, Then to be Understood." We practiced using a talking stick to be sure we were actively listening when our buddy was talking. The students worked with their buddy partners. First, the kindergarten student held the talking stick and shared their opinion on a given topic. Then, the third grade buddy had to repeat what his/her partner said. Then, if the kindergartener was satisfied, the third grade buddy had a turn to hold the talking stick and give his/her opinion on the same topic. The kindergarten buddy then had to repeat what he/she heard. This is a great strategy to use when working through conflicts to ensure each side's viewpoint is completely heard.

Math: We will work on multiplication story problems and strategies for solving them.

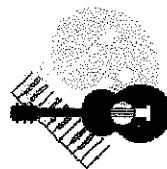
Reading: We will work on using clues from the text to determine the meaning of unknown words.
