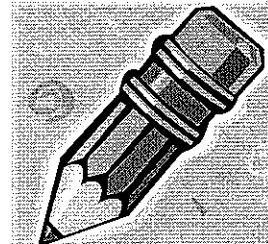

Most students will be ready to revise and edit this week.

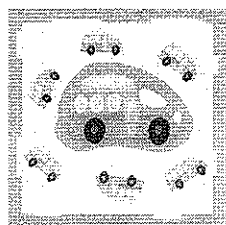
Science: We will discuss the 3 different states of matter, and how to measure liquid volume accurately.
