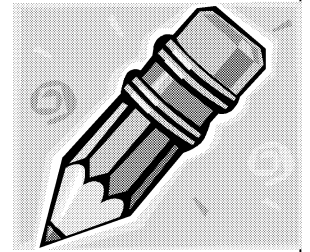

Math: We will begin our last unit called "Explore Fractions." We will be modeling with fractions, comparing fractions, and finding fractions on a number line.

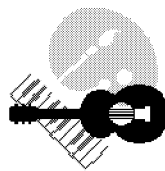
Writing: We will work on supporting our opinions with facts.

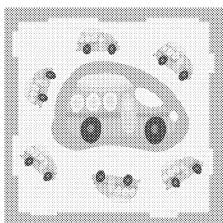
